Artwork needs to be clearly labeled and ready for hanging (wires only for 2D work) or display. While there is no size limitation for work, any extra large or heavy pieces should be reviewed by staff at the gallery prior to decision to include it in order to be able to best display it. Please call ahead to set up an appointment for viewing piece. In this case, early delivery to gallery will be okay – one trip, if piece is okayed.

Send digital image of work for possible inclusion for PR and web purposes – the sooner the better, work will not be considered for PR use until it is viewed in person by gallery staff. In this case, early delivery to gallery will be okay – one trip.
